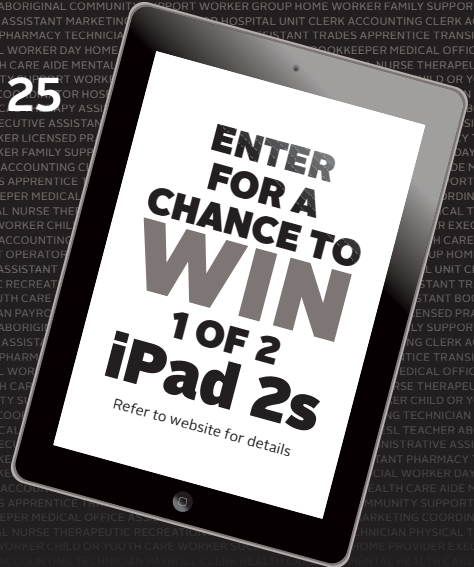

BED BUGS

An Important Reminder to Students

It is very important that everyone is informed about this pest problem. Please pass this information on to your fellow students, family and friends.

The number of bed bugs is rapidly increasing across Canada and infestations are now in Alberta and are prevalent in Edmonton.

Bed bug movement from place to place is higher during warmer weather but bed bugs move year round. If bed bugs are found in the College we notify our pest control company as part of our pest control management program.

What to do if you find a bug that you suspect may be a bed-bug

- At the College – if you discover any type of bug, inform Facilities Management immediately by phone 780-644-6215 or email at facilities@norquest.ca or come to Room A201.
- At home - if you discover a suspected bed bug in your home contact a local pest control company. They are the experts and will advise you about how to best deal with the situation. If you know that you have a bed bug problem at home ensure you take precautions to try and contain the problem at home.

Bed bugs facts

- Bed bugs are flat, brown, wingless and about the size of a sesame or apple seed.
- They can be seen with the human eye, but do a great job at hiding.
- Bed bugs feed on blood (both human and animal). They are drawn to their host via carbon dioxide.
- Bed bugs do not only reside in beds. They can live in clothing, carpets, furniture, behind baseboards and in many other areas. Bed bugs can even live in books and as such libraries can be a source for bed bugs.
- Bed bugs are easily transported and can be found anywhere. Finding a bed bug has nothing to do with the age of the building, cleanliness or personal hygiene. It only takes one bed bug to hitch a ride from one point to another. Thus if you're not careful, it is easy for a bed bug to enter your residence.

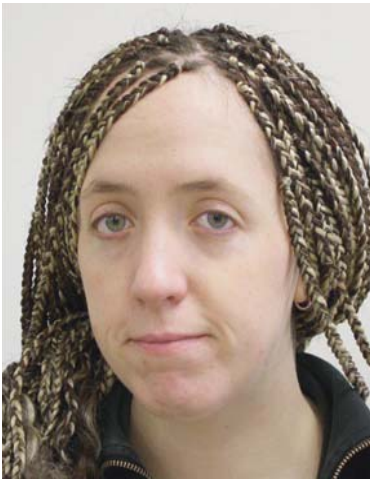
