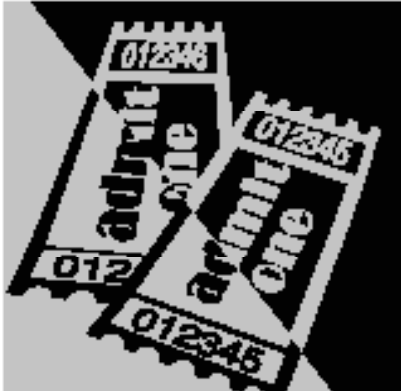

## NorQuest College President's Corner



### Budget 2011-2012 Action

The NorQuest College Board of Governors has approved a balanced 2011-2012 budget that assures the College's future and NorQuest's role as a Comprehensive Community Institution.

To achieve a balanced budget, some adjustments at NorQuest are needed due to the current financial situation. Why? Simply stated, NorQuest's expenses are increasing, but revenues are not.

NorQuest made every effort to balance the budget while making difficult, considered choices to minimize impacts to students, employees and enrolment. Over the long-term, NorQuest will work hard to achieve an optimal mix of program

opportunities for students based on NorQuest's budget.

### Budget Actions

On May 17, NorQuest's Academic Council approved the one-year deferral of registration in three programs to allow for curriculum renewal. The decision was finalized by the NorQuest Board of Governors on May 18.

Effective immediately, September 2011 registration in three programs is being deferred:

### Transitional Vocational Program

- NorQuest will make adjustments to the curriculum to better meet the needs of students.

### Digital Graphic Communications

- NorQuest will make adjustments to better meet the needs of students and industry.
- Year two of the program will run this year.

### Aboriginal Policing and Security

- The program will be redeveloped into an improved certificate/diploma program.

NorQuest is facilitating and encouraging students to enroll in our Aboriginal Community Support Worker program.

### Other savings

Other costs-saving measures are being implemented as appropriate and should have little impact to students. When more information is available, I will share it with you.

You should not notice much change in the day-to-day functioning of the College but if you do, and have questions, you may direct them to the Student' Council.
